
Make your own (Small) Skull mask

from THE POWER OF DARK


Prepare to make the mask by roughly cutting around the four parts; the head piece, the jaw, the face piece and the nose piece (including the letters next to the tabs), and gluing onto light card.

Hint: Letters are written next to the tabs to correspond with where they are to be positioned on the mask. Only cut off the reference letters just before you are about to glue the tabs into position so you don't lose your place.






Cut out the head piece and the holes for the eyes and the nose, and glue the tabs underneath to create a curved dome.




Cut out the jaw, fold the bottom piece under, curve round and glue the tabs to each side.



Glue the head piece over the jaw. (Position the sides of the head piece flush against the curved lines drawn on the jaw as shown.)



Cut out the face piece and the holes for the eyes and the nose. Cut out the nose piece and stick to the head piece around the nose hole in the centre.

(Glue down cheekbone tabs last.)

Matching the tab letters, carefully glue the face piece to the head piece, making sure the nose holes in the two parts align. Lastly, glue the ends of the two cheekbone tabs to the sides of the head piece making sure the cheekbones are pushed forward to stand proud from the mask.



Finally, using sticky tape, fix two pieces of string or wool behind the mask, tie it on, and feel the Power of Dark!
